

How Inclusive Access/Day One Works

Each Inclusive Access/Day One program is chosen and designed by your instructor, most include these seven milestones.

1

A professor adopts a title and a digital learning tool like My MathLab/Connect.

LRSC negotiates discount pricing from the publisher to save students money on required course content selected by the instructor.



2

Digital course materials are integrated directly into Blackboard.



3

Students enrolled in an Inclusive Access/Day One course are notified they have until the opt-out deadline to opt-out of their course materials.



4

On the first day of class, students click the course materials link in Blackboard to access their resources.



5

Students who drop a course before the opt-out deadline are not charged.



6

Only students who do not opt-out receive are billed in Campus Connection for the Inclusive Access/Day One materials after the last day to drop classes.



7

Students who opt-out are responsible for obtaining course materials independently.
